Dear Parents, שיחיו:

we are now entering our 30th summer here in Morristown, New Jersey. We are glad that your son will be a part of our program, and hope אי"ה that he will greatly benefit. It is our hope that we will be able to assist in his preparation for higher learning in the Yeshiva he attends next year, and give him an enjoyable time. We have carefully chosen our staff, most of them are currently working in Yeshivos, as Mashpim, and Teachers. We have worked hard to prepare a great learning program, sports, and trips, etc. to make sure that your son has a most fulfilling summer.

The Yeshivas Kayitz begins אי"ה, on Wednesday, ה"י תמוז / June 30, and ends on Wednesday, ה' אלול / August 18. The bus to Morristown will leave from Montgomery and Kingston at 2:15 P.M. Loading is at 1:30 P.M. **SHARP!** Please note that the busses will be departing Morristown on August 18 at 7:00 PM. Drop off will be at Montgomery and Kingston at approximately 8:30 P.M. אי"ה

For out of town boys that are traveling home by air or being picked up in Morristown, please note this important information: Our Grand Banquet will take place on Wednesday afternoon and will end at approximately 6:00 PM. Please try to make arrangements for your son to leave at that time or later in the evening. We will accommodate all of those that cannot leave Wednesday evening by having them sleep in Yeshiva on Wednesday evening with proper supervision. We will provide transportation to Crown Heights for those boys staying overnight on Thursday morning at 9:30 AM to arrive approximately at 11AM. Please inform us via email by June 15 if your son will be leaving Thursday morning.

Visiting Day will אי"ה be on Sunday אב י"ד / July 25, from 2:00-7:30 P.M. Please visit on visiting day only.

Send along sufficient clothing (appropriate for a Chasidische Bochur), including linen, blankets and a pillow. **The Talmidim will be wearing button down shirts during the time of learning and Davening.** The Talmidim will be doing their own laundry at a local laundromat. They will be given a card that they can add money to for laundry so there is no need for coins to be sent. Please do not send along valuable items, for we cannot be responsible for their safety. No bicycles, firecrackers, A/C (all rooms are A/C equipped), knives, skates, roller blades, skateboards, refrigerators, (any electrical appliance) or expensive games. Do not send along music or books הקודש. No radios.

Important: We are stressing the following:

1. **No PSP's iPhones, iTouch's, DVD players, laptops or any internet accessible devices**
2. Music Players & iPods are permitted providing the following conditions are met:
 - A. The video section must remain empty of **ANY** type of videos. No exceptions!
 - B. the loaded Jewish artists (singers) are *aidel* and appropriate for a Talmid
 - C. The enclosed "Student Letter & Music Player Registration form" is filled out completely and returned **before 22 Sivan 5770, June 4th 2010**
 - D. All music on the music players/iPods will be subject to counselor's approval.
3. **No Cell Phones, No Exceptions.**

As we understand the need for parents to get in contact with their children we have set up many options to do so. There are pay phones throughout the campus where Talmidim can call home. The numbers for these phones are posted on our website. If you would like to leave a message for your son, you can call our staff office, email a staff member, or email your son. There are links for this on our website. Emails are delivered daily, and messages will be given over promptly. Due to trips, handing out the emails may be delayed therefore important information should not be relayed via email. Please do not call your son at the Yeshiva office.

Please emphasize to your son, that we expect his cooperation in learning and behavior. A Talmid not living up to the standards of our program may be sent home.

Enclosed are packing list, Learning schedule and Sforim list, Please read and send along the necessary Seforim (with your son's name in them).

Also enclosed is a "Student Letter & Music Player Registration form" for your son to fill out in order for the form to be considered received:

- A. the **entire** form must be filled out,
- B. it must be sent in **before 22 Sivan 5770, June 4th 2010**

IMPORTANT: For our grand trip we need your son's passport. The passport will be held in the camp office and returned at the end of the summer. If we do not receive a valid passport, your child will not be able to participate in the grand trip.
